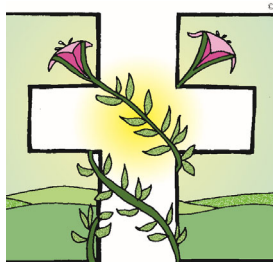

### “LENT 2019”

*“Lent is a favorable season for opening the doors to all those in need and recognizing in them the face of Christ.” - Pope Francis*

The 2019 Lenten season begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6 and continues to Palm Sunday, April 14th.

Lent is the forty-day liturgical season of fasting, special prayer and almsgiving in preparation for Easter. The name "Lent" is from the Middle English Lenten and Anglo-Saxon Lenten, meaning spring; its more primitive ecclesiastical name was the "forty days," *tessaracoste* in Greek. The number "forty" is first noted in the Canons of Nicaea (A.D. 325), likely in imitation of Jesus' fast in the desert before His public ministry (with Old Testament precedent in Moses and Elijah). By the fourth century, in most of the West, it referred to six days' fast per week of six weeks (Sundays were excluded); in the seventh century the days from Ash Wednesday through the First Sunday were added to make the number forty.

During Lent, we are asked to devote ourselves to seeking the Lord in prayer and reading Scripture, to service by giving alms, and to sacrifice self-control through fasting. Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. Contemplate the meaning and origins of the Lenten fasting tradition in this reflection. In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but also through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2446). The key to fruitful observance of these practices is to recognize their link to baptismal renewal. We are called not just to abstain from sin during Lent, but to true conversion of our hearts and minds as followers of Christ.

## "Lent 2019" cont...

We recall those waters in which we were baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ. In Lent, the baptized are called to renew their baptismal commitment as others prepare to be baptized through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, a period of learning and discernment for individuals who have declared their desire to become Catholics.

## "Cuaresma 2019"

*"La Cuaresma es una temporada favorable para abrir las puertas a todos los necesitados y reconocer en ellos el rostro de Cristo." - Papa Francisco*

La Cuaresma es la temporada litúrgica de cuarenta días de ayuno, oración especial y limosna en preparación para la Pascua. El nombre "Cuaresma" proviene del lenguaje inglés medio y anglosajón, que significa "primavera"; su nombre eclesiástico más primitivo era "cuarenta días", *tessaracoste* en griego. El número "cuarenta" se menciona por primera vez en los Cánones de Nicea (A.D. 325), probablemente en imitación del ayuno de Jesús en el desierto antes de su ministerio público (con el precedente del Antiguo Testamento en Moisés y Elías). En el siglo IV, en la mayor parte de Occidente, se refería al ayuno de seis días por semana de seis semanas (los domingos estaban excluidos); en el siglo séptimo se agregaron los días desde el Miércoles de Ceniza hasta el Primer domingo para hacer el número cuarenta.

Durante la Cuaresma, se nos pide que nos dediquemos a buscar al Señor en oración y leyendo las Escrituras, a servir dando limosnas y a sacrificar el autocontrol a través del ayuno. Muchos conocen la tradición de abstenerse de comer carne los viernes durante la Cuaresma, pero también estamos llamados a practicar la autodisciplina y el ayuno de otras maneras a lo largo de la temporada. Contempla el significado y los orígenes de la tradición de ayuno de Cuaresma en esta reflexión. Además, dar limosna es una forma de compartir los dones de Dios, no solo a través de la distribución de dinero, sino también a través de compartir nuestro tiempo y talentos. Como San Juan Crisóstomo nos recuerda: "No permitir que los pobres compartan nuestros bienes es robarles y privarlos de la vida". Los bienes que poseemos no son nuestros, sino de ellos" (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, n. 2446). La clave para la observancia fructífera de estas prácticas es reconocer su vínculo con la renovación del bautismo. No solo estamos llamados a abstenernos de pecar durante la Cuaresma, pero a la verdadera conversión de nuestros corazones y mentes como seguidores de Cristo. Recordamos aquellas aguas en las que fuimos bautizados en la muerte de Cristo, morimos al pecado y al mal, y comenzamos una nueva vida en Cristo.

En la Cuaresma, los bautizados son llamados a renovar su compromiso bautismal mientras otros se preparan para ser bautizados a través del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos, un período de aprendizaje y discernimiento para las personas que han declarado su deseo de convertirse en católicos.

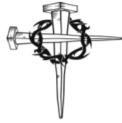

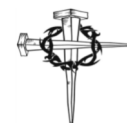
